

## **Welcome to the International Blog of Rosenheim University of Applied Sciences!**

The International Blog is an exchange platform about studying abroad for international students at Rosenheim University of Applied Sciences.

This blog addresses all students of Rosenheim University of Applied Sciences who are thinking about a study abroad stay – so-called “Outgoings” – and all international students who come to study at Rosenheim from abroad – so-called “Incomings”.

In this blog, students write about their experiences to inform other students about a stay at Rosenheim or abroad. They start with information about the preparation and organisation from home, their arrival and first days in the host country, their practical experiences and important tips for other students about studying in a foreign country.

The International Blog offers the opportunity to discuss your international experiences with other students from Rosenheim University of Applied Sciences. The contributions from other students may facilitate your decision-making process, and serve as motivation and inspiration for new potential international students, as first-hand information from students who have already studied abroad are often more helpful and authentic than theoretical advice.

**Outgoings – Experiences from students abroad:** The experiences of students of Rosenheim University of Applied Sciences who have studied or worked abroad (semester abroad, internship, final thesis, summer school or language course), in Europe or world-wide, are made available online in the International Blog.

In their contributions on the blog, students write about their experiences abroad and offer some first-hand tips and tricks about the preparation from home, the formalities in the host country and the daily life there.

**Incomings – Experiences from international students studying at Rosenheim University of Applied Sciences:** International students who come to Rosenheim to study (i.e. a study abroad stay for one or two semesters or seeking an international degree) also have the opportunity to publish their contributions and experiences in the International Blog.
