Preparation

How did you prepare your stay?

I found out about the program via a post on my network on Linkedin.

The school was focused exactly on the topic: Vehicle Dynamics and Control that I am interested in. It had advanced lectures by renowned professors from all over the world. Hence, I was sure I wanted to attend it.

The Application process included submitting my academic transcripts and it was very smooth. As soon as the application was processed and approved, I was informed of further steps to join.

Accommodation

How did you organise your accommodation?

The Host had a Guesthouse with limited vacancies. I applied there and also searched for hotel rooms in the city. Since the guesthouse was already fully booked, I reserved my stay at a hotel room near the city centre. Later a vacancy opened up at the Guesthouse and I confirmed it. The Guesthouse room was right next to the CISM Lecture Building. It was very comfortable and had an attached bathroom. I did not have to share the room as well.

Programme at host university

How did you learn during your stay at the host university?

Upon arrival, all participants first enrolled in the Program and were guided to the Lecture Hall. The Program structure, topics and lecturers were introduced by the Coordinators. A welcome gathering was hosted at the end of the lectures on the first day for the participants. The Institute Staff was very helpful and available throughout.

The Host Institute also provided WiFi access and lunch for the duration of the Program. We were also offered reference books from the library and all Lecture Notes for the program. All lectures were held in English.

The learning environment was very rich and inspiring as most of the participants were PhD Students and researchers in the field. So, everyone was passionate about the same topic. The discussions were about innovative approaches and trends in research along with doubts that students had. The Program started with a short revision of the basics of the topic and went further to the modern approaches and research areas in the field. It was hence a good challenge to take. The lecturers also presented their contributions in research and their results which were fascinating to see.

Being one of the youngest participants, I learned a lot throughout and was able to engage with researchers who have the same passion for the topic. It was one of the focused and intensive academic experiences for me.
